In order to help sustain our Coalition and the important work we do, the Texas Oral Health Coalition Board of Directors voted June 10, 2017 to implement annual membership dues effective January 1, 2018. TxOHC is a membership coalition which wants all members to feel invested and to receive the many benefits the Coalition has to offer. To encourage faculty and student membership, the Board implemented a new category called Academic Institutional. This new category emphasizes the partnership between the Coalition and various academic institutions and provides opportunities to help engage other health related institutional members as well.

Academic Institutional membership is \$350/year and includes department/program faculty and their full time enrolled students. Annual dues may be paid online on the annual Texas Oral Health Summit registration form by clicking the option button to include your membership dues with your summit registration fee. If you are not a current member, paying online before deadline during your summit registration will allow you to receive the reduced member registration fee for the upcoming summit.

Academic Institutional Membership Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be from an Accredited Institution's School Program
2. Staff members and full-time students from an accredited program
3. Dues for Academic Institutional Membership - \$350/year

Members joining under the Academic Institutional membership category, are asked to complete the individual or student online application in order to receive full member benefits.

STEPS:

1. Determine your program or department faculty representative, complete the online membership application for Academic Institutional Membership and pay the annual fee of \$350.00 via check or PayPal.
2. Faculty members complete the online individual membership application to receive full benefits.
3. Full-time students complete the online student membership application to receive full benefits.

If the school does not wish to join under this category, students are welcome to join individually themselves at \$10/year and faculty members at \$50/year.

This information may be a literary review, technique, theory, service, trend or expanded opportunity in the practice of any related health care field and/or the broader realm of oral and systemic health.
