Texas Medicaid Updates

Texas HHSC will conduct a rate hearing on Tuesday, 11/14/23 at 9:00 AM CST.

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) will conduct a hearing to receive public comment on proposed Medicaid payment rates detailed in this document (Rate packet information on G0330) on November 14, 2023, at 9:00 AM. G0330 will be implemented for both hospital and ASCs. Implementation goal is September 1, 2024.

Members of the public may attend the rate hearing in person, which will be held in Public Hearing Rooms 1.401, 1.402, 1.403 and 1.404 in the North Austin Complex, 4601 W Guadalupe St, Austin, Texas. HHSC will consider all concerns expressed at the hearing prior to final rate approval. This public hearing will be held in compliance with the provisions of Human Resources Code §32.0282 which requires a public hearing on proposed payment rate adjustments.

CMS Final Rule Includes Important Oral Health Clarification

On November 2nd Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued a final rule that announced finalized policy changes for Medicare payments under the Physician Fee Schedule (PFS). The rule included clarification to reimbursement for dental services necessary to the clinical success of certain cancer treatments.

An additional important note is that the 2023 PFS also established an annual process for stakeholders to nominate additional clinical scenarios for Medicare payment of oral health care. This nominations process will take place again early next year. The Center will have a webinar in early 2024 to discuss oral health and will include a discussion of the nominations process.

Dallas Community Water Fluoridation Update

We have been keeping you all apprised of the recent events of the Dallas City Council regarding community water fluoridation. To learn the outcome from these recent committee briefings, please read the article linked below from Kera News on November 7, 2023.

On October 16, 2023 Dr. Mary Swift with the Texas Dental Association, Dr. Johnny Johnson of the American Flouridation Society, and Dr. Philip Huang and Dr. Anh Nguyen with Dallas County Health and Human Services presented a briefing on community water fluoridation to the City of Dallas Quality of Life, Arts and Culture Committee (CDQLAC). At the end of the presentation a second briefing was requested by the committee chair to hear from the other side of the topic.

Anti-fluoridationists had their CDQLAC committee briefing on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 with Fluoride Committee Co-Chair Dr. Griffin Cole from the International Academy of Oral Medicine and Toxicology, researcher Dr. Bruce Lanphear with Simon Fraser University, and Dr. John Staniland from the Fluoride Action Network presenting.


